Scholastic Eligibility Guidelines:

1. The progress report must contain all classes taken.
2. For the progress report to be used for season eligibility, the participant must be progressing in at least 51% of their classes.
3. The progress report must be an original, not a copy.
4. The progress report must be on the Official BGC Progress Report Form. If the form is from the school, it must be on school letterhead or have a stamp or marking stating it came directly from the school.

Guidelines

1. This form must be completed with all signatures obtained.
2. Original progress report must be turned in at the end of every week prior to official event.
3. Progress report must be obtained for 4 consecutive academic weeks.
4. If no progress report is received, then player will not be permitted to play.
5. If progressing progress is received in the designated timeframe, the player is eligible for the rest of the season.
6. At the end of the designated time period, a BGC board member or member of the BGC Scholastic team must certify eligibility for the rest of the season.
