

Umpire Clinic

This year's umpire clinic is set for Tuesday April 4th and Wednesday April 5th, from 6pm to 9pm at the Montrose Community Hall – 490 9th Avenue, Montrose. Registration is online through the BCBUA website, here:

Cost is \$25 for ages 13 and under, \$50 for ages 14 and above (age as of December 31, 2017). Clinic registration costs will be reimbursed by Trail Little League once an umpire has done three league games. Umpires are paid \$15 (and a burger from Bob's Kitchen) per game. Kids born in 2006 are eligible to umpire the bases at the Minor Division level. Kids born in 2005 or earlier are eligible to umpire behind the plate. All kids are invited to attend the umpire clinic and learn the rules of baseball.

Wake the Fields

Our first planned 'work party' of the year is scheduled for **Saturday April 8th, at 10am**. Come enjoy a coffee at the park, and help us wake the fields up from their winter slumber. The concession will also need a spring cleaning, and the grill will need to be tested (sausage 'n eggers on menu for the day?).

Registration

There are two options to register for Little League this year:

- 1. Online through our website.
- 2. In person at the park during evaluations (registration form will be available at the park).

The early bird rates for registrations received by March 31st are:

- 11-12 year olds = \$100
- 9-10 year olds = \$100
- 7-8 year olds = \$85
- 5-6 year olds = \$45

Prices for returning players **increase by \$20** after **March 31st**. Kids who didn't play Little League last year will be eligible for the early bird rates regardless of when they register. But registration closes on **April 13th**.

Regardless of how you register, payment can be made online or handed in at the park during evaluations. Online payments will be tied to your TeamSnap account, so you can print out receipts for those payments at any time. Payment is due by **April 13**th.

Come Try Baseball

Trail Minor Baseball is kicking off the season by hosting a free fun day at the park. **Sunday April 9th, 12pm to 2pm**. All 5-12 year olds are invited – new and returning players. All players who attend will be entered into a raffle draw for a free 2017 Registration. Tell your friends.

Divisions

There will be four divisions of play in Little League again this season:

Major Division (10 - 12 year olds) Minor Division (8 – 11 year olds) Rookie Division (6 – 9 year olds) Blast Ball (5 – 6 year olds)

Evaluations

All 7-12 year olds are required to attend an evaluation session. Sessions will be up to 2 hours long, and are scheduled at Andy Bilesky Park as follows:

7-8 Year Olds: Monday April 10, 5:00pm 9-10 Year Olds: April 11 & 12, 5:00pm 11-12 Year Olds: April 13, 5:00pm

Players are asked to attend all evaluations for their age group. For the 9-12 year olds, additional evaluations may be scheduled the week of April $18-21^{st}$.

Age Rules

Age rules remain the same as last year. For most players, the age determination date is how old your child is on August 31st. For players born in 2004 and 2005, the age determination date is how old your child is on April 30th (these older kids continue to play based on Little League's former age rules).

The age chart for this coming ball season is shown to the right. The red outline shows a player born in July 2007 as an example.
