



In order to better prepare for the upcoming season the SWRRA is encouraging early registration to help with ice allocation, team numbers and coaching selections as well as increase the number of attendees at our Annual General Meeting. Registrations will be accepted at any time after February for the upcoming season.

1. Registrations will **NOT** be accepted without *all* three (3) cheques: registration, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit. If registration forms are sent without these three (3) cheques they will be mailed back to you.
2. Players will **NOT** be permitted to attend *any* practices or games until *all* the registration information is received to the Registrar. Player’s account must be in good standing order to participate in SWR association activities.
